

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy sets out the basis which Speway Limited ("we", "us", or "our") may collect, use or otherwise process personal data via our website https://allpips.com/ ("Website", "Allpips") and all related websites as specified below, downloadable software, mobile applications including desktop applications (collectively "Products"), and other services provided by us and on which a link to this Privacy Policy is displayed, and all other communication with individuals through written or oral means, such as email, chat or phone (collectively together with the Website and Products, our "Services"). We are committed to safeguarding your personal information that you entrust to us while using our websites and Services, including use of the following: https://allpips.com/ and other company websites including subdomains.

Personal Information

When you apply for or maintain a Allpips Demo or Live account, we collect personal information about you for business purposes; to evaluate your financial needs, to process your requests and transactions, to inform you about products and services that may be of interest to you, and to provide client service. You may choose what you receive from us at any point by accessing the notification option in your account. Such information may include:

Application Information - Information that you provide to us on applications and other forms: your name, address, birth date, social security number, occupation, assets, and income.

Transaction Information - Information about your transactions with us or our affiliates, as well as information regarding our communications with you. Examples: your account balances, trading activity, your inquiries and our responses.

Verification Information - Information necessary to verify your identity such as a passport or drivers license.

Security Technology

Speway Limited uses Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption technology to protect the information that you submit. This technology protects Users from having their information intercepted by anyone other than Allpips during transmission. We work hard to ensure that our websites are secure and that they meet industry standards. We also use additional safeguards: firewalls, authentication systems (e.g., passwords and personal identification numbers) and access control mechanisms to control unauthorized access to systems and data.



Sharing Information with Our Affiliates

As permitted by applicable law, we may share the personal information described above with our affiliates for business purposes; such as servicing client accounts and informing clients about new products and services. Our affiliates may include companies controlled or owned by Allpips, as well as companies which have an ownership interest in our company. The information we share with affiliates may include any of the information described above: your name, address, account information, etc. Our affiliates maintain the privacy of your information to the same extent that Speway limited does in accordance with this Policy.

Sharing Information with Third-Parties

With the exception of the purposes described in this Policy, Speway limited does not disclose personal information to third-party disclosures may include: sharing such information with non-affiliated companies that perform support services for your account or facilitate your transactions with Speway limited; including those that provide professional, legal, or accounting advice to Speway limited. Non-affiliated companies that assist Speway limited in providing services to you are required to maintain the confidentiality of such information to the extent they receive it and to use your personal information only in the course of providing such services and only for the purposes which Speway limited dictates. We may also disclose your personal information to third-parties in order to fulfill your instructions or pursuant to your express consent. Speway limited will not sell your personal information.

Regulatory Disclosure

Under limited circumstances, Speway limited may disclose your personal information to third-parties as permitted by, or to comply with, applicable laws and regulations. Speway limited may disclose personal information to cooperate with regulatory authorities, law enforcement agencies, to comply with subpoenas or other official requests, and as necessary to protect Speway limited's rights or property. Except as described in this Privacy Policy, your personal information will not be used for any other purpose unless we explicitly describe in what manner such information will be used at the time you disclose it to us or we obtain your permission.



Cookies

Intro

When you use our Website, Speway limited will use cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. This helps us provide you with a more relevant and effective experience, including presenting the Website according to your needs and preferences. This Cookie Policy provides you with comprehensive information about the cookies we use and the way in which we use them. You should also read our Privacy Policy in conjunction with this Policy.

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small files of information that often include a unique identification number or value, which are stored on your computer's hard drive as a result of you using our Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies as soon as you visit our Website. Cookies are frequently used on many websites on the internet and you can choose if and how a cookie will be accepted by changing your preferences and options in your browser. Some of our business partners (e.g. advertisers) use cookies on our Website. We have no access to, or control over, these cookies. The cookies do not contain personally identifying information nor are they used to identify you. You may choose to disable the cookies. However, you will not be able to access several parts of our Website if you choose to disable the cookie acceptance on your browser.

How to delete and block cookies

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Persistent Cookies We use persistent cookies for the following purposes: To help us recognize you as a unique visitor (just a number) when you return to our website and to allow us to tailor content or advertisements to match your preferred interests or to avoid showing you the same adverts repeatedly. To compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how users use our site and to help us improve the structure of our Website. To internally identify you by account name, name, email address, customer ID, currency and location (geographic and computer ID/IP address). Within research surveys to ensure you are not invited to complete a questionnaire too often or after you have already done so. Third Party Cookies Third parties serve cookies via this site. These are used for the following purposes: We use persistent cookies for the following purposes: To serve advertisements on our site and track whether these advertisements are clicked on by users. To control how often you are shown a particular advertisement. To tailor content to your preferences. To count the number of anonymous users of our site. For website usage analysis

Use of Web Beacons

Some of our Web pages may contain electronic images known as Web beacons (sometimes known as clear gifs) that allow us to count users who have visited these pages. Web beacons collect only limited information which including a cookie number, time and date of a page view, and a description of the page on which the Web beacon resides. We may also carry web beacons placed by third party advertisers. These beacons do not carry any personally identifiable information and are only used to track the effectiveness of a particular campaign.
